We may ask you to supply supporting documents as part of your application process.

These documents must be original or certified copies. If they're written in a language other than English, you'll need to submit a certified translated version along with the original copy. If any of your documents feature a previous name, please provide us with official evidence of your name change.

ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS

- Awards, certificates or official transcripts from previous undergraduate or postgraduate study.
- If your course has GPA requirements, and you fall under that range, you may still be eligible for the course you will just need to provide a Statement of Intent.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

You may need to supply evidence of your English language proficiency. There are English language requirements for this course.

There are a few ways you can prove your proficiency in English, namely through:

- Previous study in Australia or a recognised English-speaking country, including but not limited to Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, South Africa, United Kingdom and the USA
- Prior study at a recognised institution or in a recognised qualification

WORK EXPERIENCE

We might also request evidence of your relevant work experience.

- For courses that specify work experience as an entry requirement, you should include an up-to-date CV and a Statement of Employment in your application.
